1960-1965 Stroganov School, Moscow, where Chetkov was taught applied art. Famous Armenian artist Martyrs Saurian visited the school and noted to his colours and talent.

1952-1954 Enrolment to the art college "Tavricheskoe", Saint-Peterburg
1949-1952 Chetkov came to Kazakhstan, where V.A. Aifert, ex-vice director of State Tretyakov Gallery, was deported from the capital during Stalin's repression-years. For three years B.Chetkov was studying in Aifert's studio.
1945-1948 Study in applied Art College in Novaya Lialya, Sverdlovsk Region.
